

VISITATION FACT SHEET

M.M. Ewing Continuing Care Center Visitation will remain in compliance with guidance from the New York State Department of Health and CMS. Visitors must adhere to visitation guidance.

**Visitors must adhere to Core Principles of Infection Prevention as listed in the below protocol.
Visitors who fail to adhere to these principles may be asked to leave.**

PROTOCOL FOR FAMILY VISITS

TESTING REQUIREMENT	Visitors are not required to test. Visitors are welcome to use the tests available at the facility if they wish to test.
VISIT HOURS	Visitation is from 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. 7 days per week. We do encourage visitors to not visit during meal times.
SCREENING PROCESS	All visitors must be screened. Questionnaire will be conducted with any symptoms reviewed.
CONTACT TRACING	Visitors must provide accurate and updated full name, address, and phone number/email address for contact tracing purposes.
HAND HYGIENE	Hand hygiene is to be performed by visitors upon arrival, prior to interaction with their loved one. With hand sanitizer: Be sure to use it for 20 seconds, covering all surfaces and allowing hands to dry thoroughly. While visiting, please limit surfaces touched.
FACE MASK	Visitors must wear a well-fitting non-surgical paper mask or mask of higher quality covering both the nose and the mouth. (surgical mask, KN95, or N95). Visitor may wear cloth <i>over</i> surgical/KN95/N95.
SOCIAL DISTANCING	Visitors should maintain 6 feet social distancing. Visitors should not have large group visits in close spaces. If you have more than 2 visitors for a resident, please utilize a common space like the lobby or lounges to allow for social distancing to occur. Visitors should not be socializing with other residents throughout the facility.
RESTRICTIONS	The facility must refuse visitation if any individual exhibits any Covid-19 symptoms and/or does not pass the screening questions or if a visitor reports being positive for Covid. Residents with Covid-like symptoms or residents in quarantine are eligible for visits, but the visitor incurs the risk associated with potential illness.

Please Note:

1. Outdoor visitation is subject to weather conditions and still encouraged over indoor visitation if appropriate.
2. Receptionist will ask who you are visiting. If the Resident is on quarantine you will be provided with information on Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

This plan is subject to change based off guidance from NYSDOH and/or CMS. When changes occur, the MMECCC will notify Residents, families and NYSDOH accordingly.
